Our vision is to provide exceptional small business program support to our customers and optimize subcontracting opportunities for small businesses to ensure delivery of quality products and services to warfighters, on time and at cost

- **DoDD 4205.01, DoD Small Business Programs, June 2016**
- **Federal Acquisition Regulation(FAR) 42.302 (a)(52),(53),(54) and (55)**
- **FAR and DoD FAR Supplement Part 19; corresponding clauses, forms, and Procurement Guidance Information (PGI)**

- Small Business Administration (SBA)
 - Aid, assist and protect the interests of small businesses in Government procurements
 - Establish Agency/Department goals
- DoD Office of Small Business (OSBP)
 - Provide leadership and **Governance over DCMA** and to the Military and DoD Agencies Small Business Programs
 - Manage specific SB related programs (SBIR, CSP, Mentor Protégé)
- Military Services and DoD Agencies
 - Provide opportunities to small businesses when awarding prime contracts
 - Negotiate and establish goals for subcontracts when awarding contracts
- **Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA)**
 - **Tracks agency's small business goal achievement**
 - **Surveillance of contractor subcontracting program performance**
 - **Review and provide recommendations on individual plans to the military services and other DoD agencies**

- **Subcontract Plan Reviews (Individual, Commercial, and Master)**
- **Administer DoD Mentor Protégé Pilot Program Agreements**
- **Administer and Manage the Comprehensive Small Business Subcontracting Test Program (CSP)**
- **Assist with Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC) Reviews**



Highlights

- **By leveraging the SBA's role for Civilian contracts held by the same vendor as DOD contracts through DCMA, it will result in future cost avoidance – SBA will not review vendors being reviewed by DCMA**
- **Compliance review ratings in line with CPAR Ratings**
- **Improved SB Program Performance Ratings**
- **Shared information – Yearly planned reviews and reviews conducted quarterly**
- **Joint Follow Up reviews**

- **DCMA's discretionary spending is much smaller than that of the Military Departments. However –**
- **Exceeded Agency socioeconomic goals established by the DoD in most category's**
- **Frequent participation in DoD initiatives to expand the DoD Small Business industrial base (e.g. DoD HUBZone Outreach events, Procurement Technical Assistance Center events, DoD Small Business meetings)**
